

## Cosburn Avenue Bicycle Lanes Open House

Toronto Transportation Services invites you to a Public Open House to review and provide comments on a proposal to install bicycle lanes on Cosburn Avenue from Broadview Avenue to Oak Park Avenue. Plans of the bike lane design and impacts on traffic and parking will be available at the meeting. Councillors Case Ootes and Janet Davis have been invited to participate in the open house.



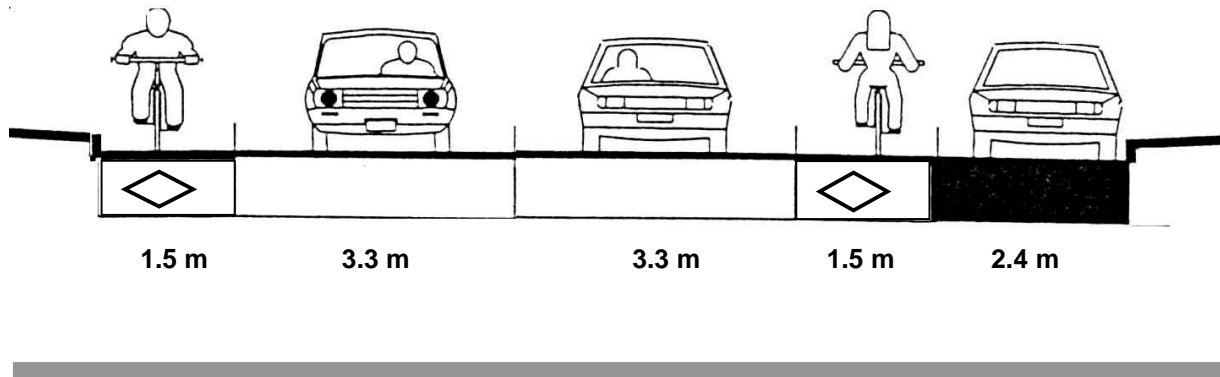
This proposal would result in the following design:

The road would be re-stripped to provide one bicycle lane and one traffic lane in each direction, with designated left turn lanes provided at signalised intersections. Parking is currently allowed on one side of Cosburn Avenue during non-peak periods within the section from Broadview to Linsmore Crescent. The proposed design will continue the parking on one side, with the added benefit to residents of allowing parking at all times of the day. East of Linsmore Crescent, parking is generally allowed on both sides of Cosburn Avenue. The proposed design will allow parking on only one side.

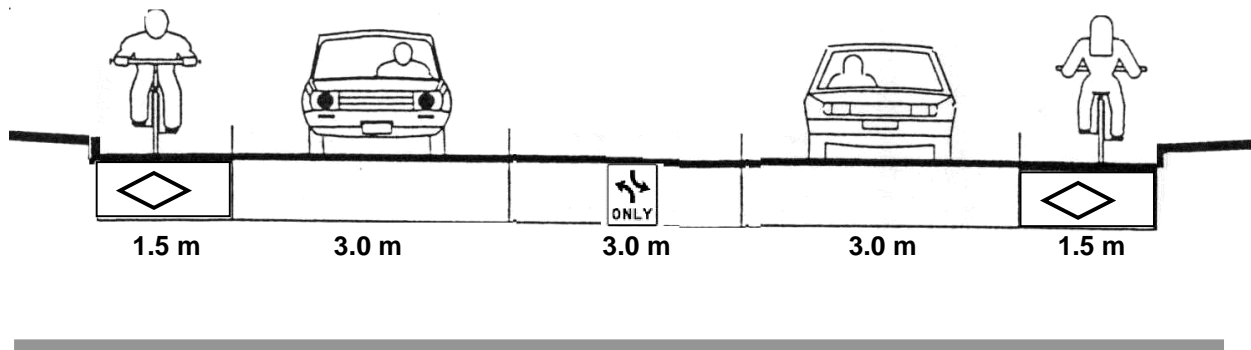
